

Math Readiness Course

(non-credit)

Who: Any incoming freshman student who is registered to take Honors Algebra II or Algebra II. This class is NOT meant for students who will be going into the 7th or 8th grade, only incoming freshmen.

What: A dedicated time to review and practice applying Algebra I concepts in order to build skills and support students' success in their next level of math. There will be an emphasis on solving & graphing linear equations and inequalities, simplifying polynomials and solving polynomial equations. Utilizing graphing calculators, students will work in small groups to apply these skills through a variety of activities.

** Students will need to bring a TI-83(+) or a TI-84(+) for this week.
