## CAMP SPECIFICS

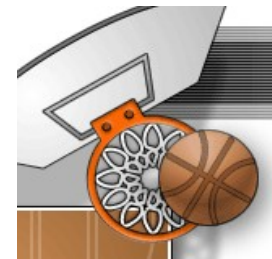

## SKILLS DEVELOPMENT CAMP

This camp is designed to improve the basketball skills by engaging players in a fun and competitive environment. Campers will receive individual instruction by both high school coaches and players.

The drills that will be introduced and reinforced will be ones that the campers will be encouraged to use throughout the summer. The drills will focus on **Ball Handling Skills, Passing, Sound Shooting Principles, Rebounding Basics, Defensive Fundamentals, along with Post and Perimeter Moves.**

Along with individual skills, campers will be introduced to team skills and concepts through 5 on 5 games. Each camper will be on a team coached by high school players and will receive equal playing time.

## SHOOTING and 3 on 3 SPECIALTY CAMP

This camp is specifically designed to introduce and develop effective shooting skills. Campers will be instructed by the high school coaches as well as the high school players.

Our focus will begin on learning what a good shot is, footwork, and how to get open. We will then focus on hand position, follow through, free throws, jump shots and post moves.

Each camper will individually see their shooting form on digital tape.

Each day campers will incorporate the shooting skills, and learn other offensive skills in a 3 on 3 setting. This will be a fun, competitive atmosphere for campers to meet students from other area schools, and improve their offensive skills.
