This summer we are offering a variety of camps for kids of all ages. HARTFORD LADY ORIOLES BASKETBALL CAMP (4th-6th grade)

Date: 6/26 to 6/29 **Gender:** Girls
Time: 12:30 pm - 3:00 pm **Location:** Hartford HS
Ages: 4th - 6th grade (summer 2017) **Cost:** \$60.00

Camp Description: The Hartford Lady Oriole Basketball Camp day starts with group instruction working on individual technique. Daily topics for the week include ball handling, passing, sound shooting principles, rebounding basics, defensive principles, along with post and perimeter moves. Technique training is followed by the daily camp contest. Team skills and concepts will be learned through 3-on-3 and 5-on-5 games in a round robin set up.

What Players Receive: Four days of fun and exciting basketball activities and a camp t-shirt, quality one-on-one instruction from High School Coaches and Players.

Time: 12:30 pm - 3:00 pm **Location:** Hartford HS
Ages: 7th - 9th grade (summer 2017) **Cost:** \$60.00

Camp Description: This camp is specifically designed to introduce and develop effective shooting and scoring skills. Our focus will be on learning what a good shot is, footwork, and how to get open. Each camper will have the opportunity to see their shooting form on digital tape and be analyzed individually by Coach Shelsta. All campers will be instructed on specific attack moves from the perimeter and post moves that will improve their scoring abilities. Each day campers will incorporate the shooting/scoring skills they receive in 1-on-1, 3-on-3, and/or 5-on-5 settings.

What Players Receive: Four days of fun and challenging basketball, a "Lady Oriole" Camp T-shirt, quality one-on-one instruction from High School Coaches and Players.
