Criteria: University of Wisconsin System School (Must be a four-year program) – Majoring in Education

GRACE & GLENN BROKER FAMILY

Criteria: Student is a graduate of Central Middle School or St. Kilian's School, with first choice entering the field of teaching or nursing.

ELMER J. EBLING

Criteria: Student pursuing degree pertaining to agriculture at college. Discretion of Committee if agricultural candidate not available.

FIRST NATIONAL BANK – HARTFORD

Criteria: Emphasis on B. S. Degree in Business Administration majoring in Banking and Finance preferred, but not restricted to.

HARTFORD and KETTLE MORAINES LIONS CLUBS ENDOWMENT FUND - JACK BELL MEMORIAL – 2 Endowed

Criteria: Baccalaureate Degree - Four-year college

HARTFORD ROTARY CLUB

Criteria: Evidence of Community Service, broad participation in activities, scholarships, diligence and good character.

HARTFORD ROTARY CLUB – 3/\$1,500

Criteria: four-year school – Academic excellence, extra-curricular activities, financial need, and potential interest and desire for community service.

HARTFORD SAVINGS BANK

Criteria: Recipient must possess a minimum GPA of 2.333 on 4.0 scale at time of selection. Recipient must attend a Wisconsin educational facility providing a four-year degree.

HUHS FACULTY & STAFF – 3 Endowed

Criteria: 4 year Baccalaureate, which could lead to a teaching degree if qualified candidate available. Discretion of Board of Directors.

HARTFORD LIONESSE - \$1000

Criteria: College/University (undergrad-degree).

BRIAN J. JANZER MEMORIAL

Criteria: Career in Auto Mechanics, Agricultural Field, Engineering Field or Police Science. Special consideration given to FFA member, who meets criteria. Discretion of Board if not enough candidates meet above criteria.

DR. PETER AND DR. LAURA JOOSSE HEALTHCARE - \$500

Criteria: Pursuing Bachelors in nursing or pre-medicine with an interest in Gerontology or Psychiatry, GPA of 3.0 or higher.

NOELLE KRAEMER EDUCATIONAL - \$500

Criteria: Recipient must have overcome a physical or medical challenge (unexpected circumstances) during his/her high school years (preferably senior year), still met goal of graduation. If no candidate meets above criteria, then student pursuing a degree in Spanish or a Service field. Recipient must write thank you discussing college plans, (school/field of study etc).

RUTH A. KNOLL MUSIC

Criteria: Career in music related field with preference given to Music Education or Vocal Performance (first) or Instrumental Performance (second). Must have participated at least 3 years in a credited performing ensemble, maintained a 3.0 GPA and shows financial need. May re-apply in subsequent years. Discretion of committee if all qualifications are not met.

Criteria: Alternating year – **Four year degree - 2012** (Vocational/Technical degree)

JIM & DOREEN MOHR ARTS EDUCATION

Criteria: Arts Education course of study leading to a degree in a school or college of education, leading to a career teaching arts at the elementary, secondary or college level. Student's competence and financial need. **This can be renewed and may be awarded to the same individual more than once.**

COL. GARY L. PIKE – HARTFORD MASONIC LODGE BY KENNETH & JANET PIKE - 2/\$1000

Criteria: Current graduate of HUHS, preferably UW-Madison, in an engineering program, if none available, it may be modified to include "UW System.

FLORENCE PLACE TRUST

Amount and number to be determined at a later date based on income of the Trust.

Criteria: Based upon financial need.

KENNETH and ANITA REED

Criteria: Candidate to pursue 4 yr degree (no restrictions), have maintained a "C" average through-out high school, and may apply for a second year.

DEL & ELLIE RENZAGLIA

Criteria: Emphasis on need and student pursuing a four year degree.

JACK & GERRY RUSSELL – 3 Endowed

Criteria: First elementary education or nursing. Special financial need as determined by the committee. Student may receive scholarship additional years, on a yearly basis, up to a Bachelors' degree based on academic achievement, maintaining 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and school or community involvement.

MARY ROEMER THOMAS

Criteria: Top Quarter of Class, Strong interest in Chemistry and technology, Diverse interest in outside activities.

THOMAS H & LORI L SEEBOTH

Criteria: Maintain C+ or better average, no underage alcohol or drug violations, involved in extracurricular activities and volunteer activities, two letters of rec., one from extra & volunteer advisor explaining accomplishments.

NATE STROBEL - \$500

Criteria: Student pursuing 4 year degree in Mechanical Engineering (any engineering field if no candidate) priority to student who was member of HUHS Soccer Program

WEST BEND CLINIC – 3/\$1000

Criteria: GPA in upper 10% of class. Involvement in co-curricular, community service, and similar activities considered. Attend any accredited four (4) year university or college in career of their choice. Student may reapply for an additional three (3) years with proof of 3.0 on a 4.0 grade scale.

Criteria: Career in healthcare, academic achievement, active involvement in extracurricular activities or community. Two or four yr program.

AURORA MEDICAL CENTER - MEDICAL STAFF - \$1000

Criteria: Career in healthcare, academic achievement, active involvement in extracurricular activities, interests, community and financial need.

JIM AND JEAN BELL

Criteria: Attend a PUBLIC college, university or technical school. Original recipient could re-apply for succeeding years up to a total of four years. Recipient must have met academic standards of the school to re-apply. If above standards are met would like original recipient to receive scholarship for four years.

COURTNEY-CARR-MILNER AMERICAN LEGION POST #19 SCHOLARSHIP - \$500

Criteria: College, university or technical school, child or grandchild of a U.S. Veteran and three letters of recommendation, One (1) from high school principal, counselor or teacher and two (2) representative citizens (non-relative). If for any reason the scholarship is not used, the money will be used the following year to fund the scholarship for that year.

HARTFORD COMMUNITY SERVICE, INC. TERROR ON RURAL STREET – 3/\$1000 2/Endowed

Criteria: Student must have minimum 2.333 on 4.0 scale, grade point average, minimum of 20 hours of volunteer or community service work in the past 4 yrs, letters of recommendation one from volunteer or community service supervisor, 3 or more co-curricular activities during high school. Four-year college or two-year technical/vocational school degree.

HARTFORD ELECTRIC AND WPPI Inc. - \$1000

Criteria: First priority given to student whose legal guardian is a customer of the CITY OF HARTFORD ELECTRIC at the time of application. Student planning to attend an accredited Electrical Power Distribution School such as the Moraine Park Technical College in Beaver Dam, or if no one applies, to worthy individual pursuing post secondary education in any field.

HARTFORD PLAYERS FINE ARTS

Criteria: Major field of study should be visual arts, performance arts, or education field within the arts. 3.0 GPA or higher.

THE HARTFORD AREA FOUNDATION - \$1000

Criteria: College or technical school.

HARTFORD WOMENS CLUB - \$750

Criteria: 4 yr or technical school. Major field of study should be Business related. Minimum of 20 hours of volunteer or community service in the Hartford area community during the past four years. Demonstrate a financial need or hardship. GPA "B" average or above. Not limited to upper percentile of class rank.

HARTFORD MASONIC LODGE - \$1000

Criteria: Commendable academic record, attend public or private school, course of study leading to baccalaureate or associate degree. Leadership ability involved in school, community and church or synagogue.

HUHS DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Discretion of the committee.

RENO ZANCANELLA HARTFORD MASONIC LODGE - \$1000

Criteria: Commendable academic record, attend public or private school, course of study leading to baccalaureate or associate degree. Leadership ability involved in school, community and church or synagogue.

KENEALY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF CHARLES JOSEPH KENEALY - \$1000

Criteria: Discretion of the Board.

JIM KREUSER WOODWORKING MEMORIAL

Criteria: Student should have minimum grade point average of 2.333 on 4.00 scale. Either 2-year technical degree or 4 year baccalaureate degree. Education and professional direction focusing on cabinetry, woodworking or other wood craftsmanship. If suitable candidate not available, a degree and profession in other technical discipline.
