# ACP: Academic & Career Planning

Wisconsin students are required to develop an ACP plan throughout middle and high school.

The **HUHS ACP** plan takes the state requirement and expand it to include...

- Activities that connect you with colleges and careers.
- Courses that help you figure out possible careers.
- Hands-on opportunities to explore life after high school.

ACP Portfolio contains 3 sections:

- Career Ready - - Choose from a number of experiences.
- College Ready - - Choose from a number of experiences.
- Citizenship Ready - - All students complete specific experiences.

# ACP: Academic & Career Planning

## Career Ready

- Participate in Youth Apprenticeship
- Business and industry certifications
- Attend a Career Tour
- Go on a Job Shadow
- Tour a university, tech college, trade school, military recruiter
- Have a part-time job or internship
- Take the ASVAB
- Participate in 2 or more co-curricular activities (club, sports, etc.)
- Take a class directly linked to your career goal and write a reflection
- 90% or better attendance for 1 school year
- Other experiences with prior approval



# ACP: Academic & Career Planning

## College Ready

- Dual-credit, transcribed credit CAPP
- Early College Credit Program Course or Start College Now Course
- Project Lead The Way (PLTW) course
- AP course
- Tour a university, tech college, trade school
- Participate in 2 or more co-curricular activities (club, sports, etc.)
- Complete a scholarship application
- Meet all 4 ACT college benchmarks
- Submit the FAFSA
- Other experiences with prior approval

- AP course
- Tour a university, tech college, trade school
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# Experience Completion Process

1. Identify an experience.
2. Print off one of the forms: *Career or College Experience*.
3. Check which experience will be completed.
4. Identify whose signature will be needed and put information at the bottom
5. Fill in the date completed, description of activity, and person to verify with their email address.
6. After completing the experience, get the verification person's signature
7. Complete the reflection.
