What's Different?

Academic Feedback, or homework and the Cumulative Exam counting towards the academic grade. In the past only proficiency assignments counted and the semester exam was determined by the teacher. The semester exam will also show on the report card as a separate grade.

Re-Assessment Policies

C

The highest grade that can be earned on a re-assessment is a C or a 75% or a 3

Students are allowed TWO reassessments per semester per course



Students must complete the required re-learning activities/work prior to re-assessing

Re-Assessments on Feedback work will be up to teacher discretion

What's Still the Same?

- ✓ Students must have put forth full effort on the initial attempt to reassess
- ✓ Reassessments may be in a different format, but cover the same learning targets/essential questions that were initially covered
- ✓ Teachers may choose to only require re-assessment of non-proficient skills/tasks, it is up to the teacher discretion
- ✓ Re-assessments should occur in a timely manner

Late Work Policy

C Any work submitted after the clearly communicated due date may earn a **MAXIMUM** of a C (75%/3)

Late work will only be accepted until the end of the current unit - after which it will be a **zero**

C If the late work is the unit's final assessment, then it falls under the re-assessment policy which states a maximum grade of a C (75%/3)

*Teacher discretion will be used for late work.
