Dear Parent or Guardian of:

You are receiving this letter because your child has failed the following core academic course(s) and/or your child is in danger of failing the following core academic course(s) for 2nd semester: HUHS offers students the opportunity to recover failed courses during summer school beginning Monday, June 18 through Friday, July 13 from 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM (no classes July 4).

Students may recover multiple core academic courses during summer school. Students are required to attend until all learning targets are met, at which point they will earn a Pass/Fail grade and ½ credit per course. Students who do not attend summer school will need to make up their required coursework in the future in order to fulfill HUHS graduation requirements. Next school year's course elective options will be limited if current coursework is not recovered.

If you do not have access to a computer, your child may pick up a paper copy in the Student Services Office. Enrollment will be on a first come, first served basis.

Confirmation letters and student schedules will be mailed after all registration forms have been processed, typically after June 1. Students will be required to observe all school rules during summer school. **Only one excused absence is allowed.** Please note that **transportation is not provided for summer school.**

If your child is currently failing a core academic course, he/she has access to his/her teachers and various support structures to pass the class prior to the end of the school year. These options include:

- Meeting with their teacher before or after school
- FLEX time, the 20 minutes before or after lunch
- Resource period 2:05 - 2:45 every day
