Camp Description: This introductory camp is designed for the little soccer enthusiast! Camp begins with a fun warm-up focusing on individual soccer skills, cooperation and teamwork. Players will then be split into teams and play 3 v 3 modified games on small sided fields.

Camp Description: The HUHS Oriole soccer camp day starts with group instruction working on individual technique. Daily topics for the week include ball mastery, shooting, passing, receiving and defending. All campers train in age appropriate grade levels with a 1:8 coach to camper ratio. Technique training is followed by the daily camp contest and team games.

Camp Description: The HUHS Future Stars Soccer Camp is your chance to work with the high school coaching staff and team. Daily topics for the week include ball mastery, shooting, passing, receiving and defending. Technique training is followed by small-sided games as well as situational soccer. This camp allows for the inexperienced player to learn the game and the experienced player to work on their technical and tactical game.
